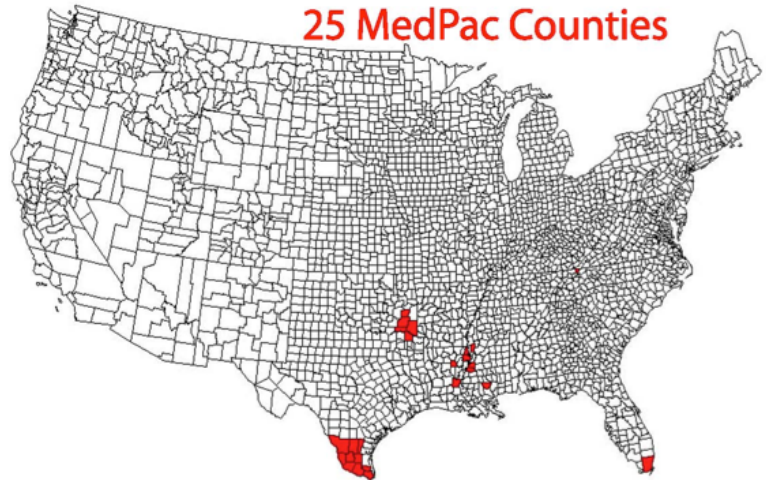


Fraud & Abuse is a Targeted Problem in Need of a Targeted Solution

THE PROBLEM ISN'T IN RHODE ISLAND:

The provider growth in Rhode Island between 2005-2009 decreased, while the MedPAC 25 **grew more than 167%**.

The percentage cost increase to Medicare in the MedPAC 25 between 2005-2009 was **more than 7 times** the increase in the state of Rhode Island.
